<p><b>for ANY "low/limited income" pet owner/guardian</b> (disabled, unemployed, receiving assistance, etc.) these organizations make modest payments to participating community veterinarians in your name thereby reducing your cost to fix your dog or cat. Call AFTER you make appt. – or - they can recommend a vet in your area if needed.</p>	<p>(One exception – Moreno Valley Clinic does not use these programs.)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Actors &amp; Others</b>, 818-755-6045, Mon-Fri, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.; if get a busy signal, hang-up &amp; redial quickly to get through. Say you're calling for financial help to fix your pet(s); &amp; you're NOT getting a voucher because Riverside County has no voucher program; &amp; you got the referral info through POPCO's website</li> <li><b>Pet Assistance Foundation</b>, 877-772-9738. When recording starts, dial 1# to stop it, and then clearly state your name, phone #, and <b>repeat</b> your phone #. A Volunteer will call you back. (Pledging is limited to 6 vets/clinics.)</li> </ol>
<p><b>for City of Riverside low-income pet owner/guardian,</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Save-A-Pet</b>, 951-781-6319, for residents of City of Riverside and nearby communities who use Town &amp; Country Vet Clinic, Pedley Square Vet Clinic, Riverside County/City Clinic, or Ramona Humane Society Clinic. (Clinics' phone #'s are listed above.)</li> </ol>
